- No pesticide/herbicide use
- Nectar and pollen sources from May to October
- All native plants (straight species)
- No cultivars
- Multi-use Plants (serving bees, butterflies, birds, etc.)
- Observed all of the following:
 - Four species of at-risk bees
 - All life stages of bees
 - All species of bees foraging for nectar and pollen
 - Birds nesting
 - Birds feeding on plants (seeds, berries)
